Der Windhoeker Künstler Alfeus Mvula hat ein DAAD-Stipendium für ein einjähriges Kunststudium in Bremen erhalten. Vor seiner Ankunft in Bremen Ende November hat er in der Nationalgalerie in Windhoek ausgestellt und einen viermonatigen Sprachkurs am Carl-Duisburg-Zentrum in Köln besucht.

Es ist das erste Mal, dass der Deutschen Akademischen Austauschdienst (DAAD) an einen Künstler aus dem unabhängigen Namibia ein Stipendium vergibt. Dort arbeitet Alfeus Mvula vor allem mit den relativ weichen Seifen- und Specksteinen. An der Hochschule für Künste in Bremen wird Mvula hauptsächlich bei Professor Dr. Peter W. Schäfer an der Hochschule für Künste in Bremen studieren und Neues im Bereich Bildhauerei dazuzulernen.
